
Due to large increases in LTL Electronics and Truckload volume, 2006 has been a challenging year providing service for the Special Products division. Limited fleet sizes required us to rely on Brokerage and Household Goods vans for supplemental hauling in order to service our customers. Now, as we enter a traditionally slower time of year for Special Products tonnage, we are loosening booking restrictions and accepting nearly every booking opportunity presented to us.

Through the year, we have worked with a group of our largest bookers and haulers to develop ways to become more efficient, while providing opportunities to increase booking revenue. As a result of this group's efforts, several policy changes were recently approved by the Board of Directors.
